4)	Add your livestream source key. The source is YouTube live (embed), Facebook Live (embed), Twitch (channel), Livestream.com (link). <i>Tip: If you're using Zoom to stream to YouTube Live, you might find this article from Zoom helpful</i>
	Livestream source key Facebook: Click on the share button and select embed. This will give an entire snippet, take the FULL url from the src= attribute and put it in the field below Youtube/Twitch: ONLY the key Twitch = https://twitch.tv/choppertown, only put choppertown in the source key. Youtube = "< iframe width" within that snippet will be "src=" https://youtube.com/embed/the_code_we_need" Livestream.com = Enter the URL located in the embed code from livestream.com
5)	Click Enable Virtual Module and Save Changes
	Enable Virtual Module (Will activate the virtual module page and be accessible publicly)

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	Make Livestream Live (Will redirect users from the front page to the livestream page)
	Activate Ticket gating (only ticket holders can log into the chat)
	Make login REQUIRED (can't watch stream without logging into the chat, via email or ticket if ticket gating is enabled)
6)	Click on Preview Livestream to the right to run through or check your livestream before your event is live

7)	Set a date and time for your livestream event
	Livestream Date Setting a livestream date will show a countdown on the page. Not setting it will just show the default livestream that was set in the livestream source key. mm/dd/yyyy :
